Opening Day is Only ONE Week Away (but you can STILL sign-up for the Strikers)!!!

Dear Prospective Soccer Players & Parents:

You might have noticed that is starting to cool down and the some of the leaves are starting to change, which means that in just **ONE** week it will be time for **Solomon's Strikers Soccer**. Like the last few years, once again this fall we are going to run our wonderful Solomon's Strikers program on a league basis (as opposed to a more of a clinic basis as we had done in some past years). With this type of program, we will form teams and play scheduled games. However, in order for this style of program to be a complete success, we need your help with two important matters:

- Enclosed is the Strikers' Registration Form. Please fill it out and send it in as soon as possible, so that we will be able to form teams, and then order and sort through jerseys and equipment before the start of the season.
- In order to be able to form teams, we **STILL** need **parents to volunteer to act as coaches**. We **STILL** are also looking for **older siblings in Middle and High School** to assist in our very successful **Junior Coaching Program** (*this is great for Community Service credits that many schools require*). We plan to have a Coaches' Clinic before Opening Day, so if you've never coached or do not even understand soccer, don't let that stop you from volunteering. The rewards are great, so **please volunteer and help out our kids!**

Our Solomon's Strikers program, which is open to all children from Kindergarten through 5th grade, is scheduled to begin on Sunday, September 14th, and run every Sunday through November 16th. Each session is scheduled to run from 9:30 to 11:00 AM at the Solomon Schechter Day School in Jericho. The first half hour will be devoted to warm-ups, instruction and practices. Scheduled games will then follow for the remaining hour.
