We have had very successful seasons the last few years and plan for more great fun this coming Spring. Once again this Spring we are going to run our Sluggers' program on a league basis. With this type of program, we will form teams and play scheduled games. However, in order for this style of program to be a complete success, we need your help with two important matters:

- In order to be able to form teams, we will need **parents to volunteer to act as coaches**. The rewards are great, so **please volunteer and help out our kids!** We especially need parents of our older players (fourth grade and up) to volunteer. We are also looking for young men and ladies in Middle or High School to assist in our program as **Junior Coaches** (this is great for those who have "Community Service" requirements for their schools).

Our Solomon's Sluggers program, which is open to all children from Kindergarten through 5th grade (including your friends who may not go to our school), is scheduled to begin on Sunday, March 21st, and run every Sunday through June 13th (we will only take off the Sundays May 23rd, for the Salute to Israel Parade and May 30th for Memorial Day weekend). **All games are played at the Solomon Schechter Day School of Nassau County (in Jericho), where each session runs from 9:30 to 11:30 AM.** This year we are very pleased to announce an **important new addition** to our program, which we will be bringing in **Professional Baseball Instructors** to work with our children (much like with do with Striker's Soccer). We think that this will greatly enhance our program and we are very happy to add it.
